It is important for us to celebrate marriages that have endured the test of time, because they call us to what is best in humanity. There may be a few couples who have lived long married lives without hardship, but I've never met them! Marriage is challenging. Any vocation is hard and worth it! It is a sharing in the life of Christ and therefore a sharing in the cross. This vocation will sanctify us if we let it, and destroy us if we don't.

Fr. Mike Schmitz spoke at a wedding recently commenting on the first reading from the Book of Tobit. In the story, Sarah has sadly been married to seven husbands, all of whom died on their wedding night. Now she meets young Tobias, the hero of the story, and they are to be married. But there is a difference at heart and in their intentions! Before they go to bed, Tobias says, "Get up. Let us pray and beg our Lord for deliverance." Tobias recounts the goodness of God recounting, "You made Adam and you gave him his wife Eve to be his help and support... You said, 'It is not good for the man to be alone; let us make him a partner like himself.' Now Lord, you know that I take this wife of mine, not because of lust, but for a noble purpose. Call down your mercy upon me and on her, and allow us to live together to a happy old age."

As Fr. Mike noted, Tobias isn't afraid of death. Unlike the other husbands, Tobias is not going to die because of her, but for her! The scriptures point out that "love is strong as death." To love means to give of yourself. Married love gives all: lifelong, faithful, and open to new life. Husbands are called to lay down their life for their wife as proof of their love, and the wife to submit to and be helpmate to this kind of lover.

In the messiness of human existence it's not quite that simple of course. The disappointments are not lacking and the wounds from the spouse perhaps the most surprising. It's hard enough if someone tells a lie about us. But it can be amazingly painful to hear the truth about ourselves! That's why, in Bishop Sheen's words, "It takes three to be married," and that third is God. Without God and his strength how hard it is to stay together, let alone to grow through the hurts.

So on the weekend of June 26<sup>th</sup> we commemorate those who have "survived the great period of trial;" we ask God's blessing on them, and we try to imitate their success.

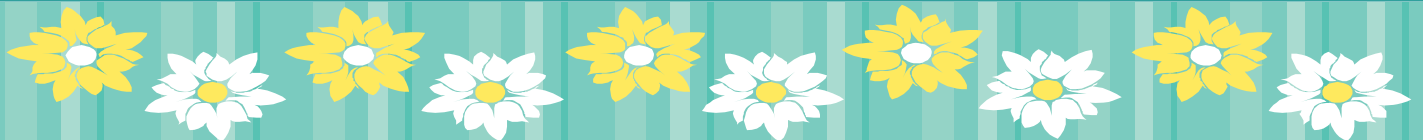

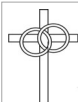

## Pro-Life Corner

Studies show that abortion hurts men as well as women:

### 1. **The pain of broken relationships.**

Surveys demonstrated that more than 50% of the male-female relationships end within one year after the abortion of their child.

### 2. **Moral guilt.**

Of 1,050 men interviewed by the Los Angeles Times, two-thirds of those who acknowledged having fathered an aborted child said they felt guilty about it, and one-third acknowledged feelings of regret. These rates surpassed those which the Times found among post-abortive women.

### 3. **Feelings of helplessness and impotence.**

The law systematically excludes a man from his wife's (or partner's) decision to abort. Men are helpless to save their child, despite the fact that more than 60 percent of surveyed men believe men should be consulted under the law before their partners abort. Although many men want to protect their offspring, the Times found that aborting women only consulted their child's father 43% of the time.
