### PROTECTIVE MEDICAL DECISION DOCUMENTS

With Health Care Reform in the forefront these days, it is important that we all have Health Care Directives in the event we need them. It is not prudent to use the Minnesota Living Will which is available through most doctors and at all hospitals. The Minnesota Living Will is too restrictive and opens the door to Euthanasia.

Please see Sharon Pero for "A Catholic Guide to End-of-Life Decisions" that is in accord with Catholic moral teaching on end-of-life issues. They are the form used by Deacon Stephen Najarian and put out by the National Catholic Bioethics Center. The forms are free of charge. This document provides latitude in patient care provided and always stipulates that food and water do not constitute extraordinary means of sustaining life but are required components of care. The individual drafting the document should keep one for him/herself, one for the designated person responsible for making decisions if you are unable to do so, and one for your health care provider.

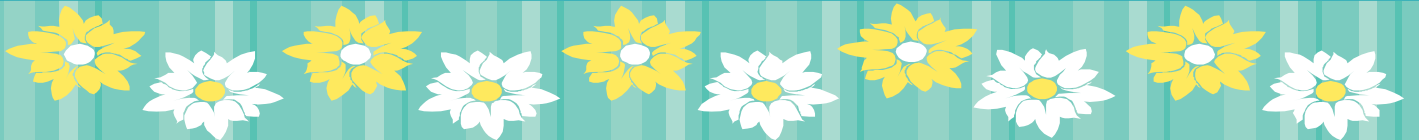

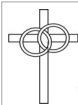

CONGRATULATIONS to Carrie Havlicek who participated in Robbinsdale Women's Center walk recently and was one of the top ten walkers with the money she collected. Thank you Carrie for getting involved and helping save a life! Way to go Carrie! Also, thank you to anyone who donated money to the walk.

So far this year Robbinsdale has saved 70 babies from abortion!



A survey of the Republic of Ireland shows that 70 percent of Irish people support the constitutional protection for the unborn, including the prohibition of abortion. The survey asked respondents if they favor or oppose "constitutional protection for the unborn that prohibits abortion but allows the continuation of the existing practice of intervention to save a mother's life in accordance with Irish medical ethics." Seventy percent supported the constitutional protections while only 13 percent opposed it. Another 16 percent of respondents did not know or had no opinion. The Pro-Life Campaign's Dr. Berry Kiely announced the results in April: "All human beings share a common dignity by virtue of their humanity. To deny the right to life simply because the unborn child is at an early stage of development completely undermines an authentic vision of human rights." She also said Ireland should be "immensely proud" that it is currently listed as the safest country in the world for pregnant women by the latest U.N. survey on maternal health. The survey was conducted in early 2010 using a quota-controlled sample of 950 people over the age of 18. (<http://www.catholicnewsagency.com>)
