## *The Pastor's Page*

### **Corpus Christi**

Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, which is translated as the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. On this feast we publicly renew our faith in Jesus Christ's real presence in the Holy Eucharist. As Jesus said, "My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. The man who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him up on the last day."

Sadly, many think that Jesus' presence in the Eucharist is only symbolic, that it is a reminder of his love, or a reminder of his presence. It is that and more: IT IS REALLY HIM! Jesus promised to remain with us until the end of the world, and that promise is fulfilled in the most extraordinary way in his Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist. Those who share in our faith and discipleship are privileged to eat his flesh and drink his blood, not like other foods that we transform into ourselves, but that we might be transformed into him! By Baptism we were forgiven our sins, made adopted sons and daughters of God. In the Eucharist he feeds us with the Body and Blood of his son, Jesus Christ. We are in fact divinized by grace! We are made holy by God himself!

Yet this gift of love in the Eucharist is meant not only to be received in the Mass as we actively participate in the worship of God. His divine presence is meant also for our consolation and intimacy. We are privileged to spend time with Jesus in the Holy Eucharist in our Adoration Chapel where he is exposed in the monstrance for our sake. I encourage you to spend time daily or at least weekly in the Adoration Chapel. It is here that intimacy with God grows, and here that troubles melt away. Jesus is present with us in the Eucharist, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity to lead us to salvation.

I have always wanted to rebuild a V-8 engine. Since my teenage years I've studied motors and reveled in them. My friends have raced cars and tinkered with them, but we never rebuilt one from the ground up. I've admired the Chevy 350s, especially the high horse power versions with the 4 bolt mains, and I like the Chevy Big Blocks for pure power, but have never had a chance to rebuild one. All that began to change this week!

A fellow I met is a daytime engineer and an evening engine rebuildier for stock cars, and he invited me to work with him and learn how to rebuild a motor! If you know how an engine works in some detail, you've got the basics. But there are levels beneath that are fascinating to explore. We began with the engine disassembled and thoroughly cleaned. Our first task was to bed the crank. We started by changing the main bearings and cleaning the crank shaft, and the process went so smoothly that after torking down the bolts we could turn the crank by hand! Next came the pistons and rings. The heads will come next week if time allows.

In addition to learning the process and how it's done, what I really enjoyed was learning what's really important and what's not. In any endeavor some things are more important than others, and beginners don't know which is which. In this case, no money was "wasted" on boiling the block; pressure wash was enough for our application, and soap and water, to my surprise, was sufficient to clean the crank! But the tiniest burrs on the crank shaft or caps had to be filed or sanded, and certain notches for bearings made perfectly clean. One mistake here could drastically shorten the whole life of the engine.

The Christian life is like that too. We want to live the whole faith. It's all important, but certain areas are critical. Seemingly small errors can be utterly destructive. Most of these "rough spots" are in the moral life and they're more important than we know.

## Pro-Life Corner

**Bernard Nathanson** (born 1926) is an American medical doctor from New York who gained national attention by becoming one of the founding members of the National Abortion Rights Action League, now known as NARAL Pro-Choice America. He worked with Betty Friedan and others for the legalization of abortion in the US. Their efforts essentially succeeded with the Roe vs Wade decision. He was also for a time the director of the Center for Reproductive and Sexual Health, New York's largest abortion clinic. Nathanson has written that he was responsible for more than 75,000 abortions. The development of ultrasound, however, in the 1970s led him to reconsider his views on abortion. He is now a staunch supporter of the pro-life movement. He is often quoted as saying abortion is "the most atrocious holocaust in the history of the United States." In 1984, he made the documentary *The Silent Scream*, which showed an abortion visualized by ultrasound.
