This is Holy Week

Well it's spring and Easter is still a long way off! So I want to challenge you: **DON'T GIVE UP NOW!** Even though the good weather has finally come, and you're thinking of Spring Cleaning, washing the car, getting your garden ready, **WAIT ANOTHER WEEK.**

Let this week be Holy Week. Save the ever so necessary and enjoyable tasks for one more week, and **MAKE THIS HOLY WEEK!** We make it holy by letting Spring bud forth in our hearts first of all. Walk with Jesus from his triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, through the Dinner at Bethany when Mary Magdalen washed his feet with her tears. We hear of the betrayal of Judas at the daily Mass readings, and of Jesus gently and privately calling him back. We continue the walk through the Mass of the Lords Supper on Holy Thursday at 8:00PM. Jesus asks, "Could you not watch with me one hour?" and we watch with him some time that night before midnight. On Good Friday we fast with the whole Church and attend the Liturgy of the Passion at 2PM. On Holy Saturday night we celebrate the Easter Vigil at 8:00PM as we proclaim the Resurrection from the dead!

Make this week holy by your holy activity. With the crucified and risen Lord in your heart, you'll have time enough for everything else in the weeks to come.
